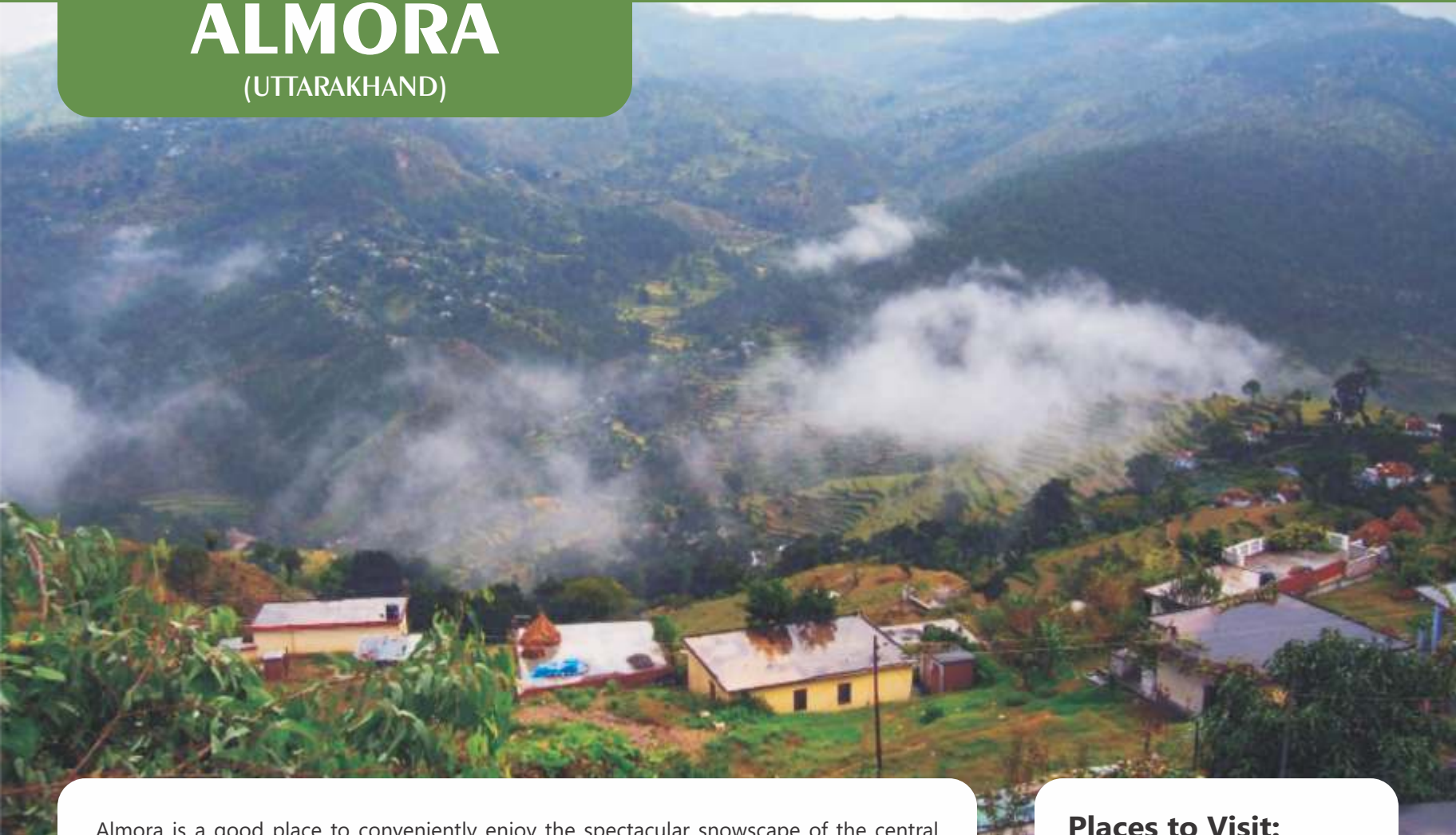


ALMORA

Almora was the seat of power of the Chand Dynasty who ruled the land of Kumaon for almost one thousand years.

An interesting fact about the discovery of Almora is that unlike other hill stations, it was not discovered and developed by the British. There are a number of places of tourist interest around Ranikhet. Chaubatia is famous for its orchards; Tarikhet, eight kilometers away, was once the nerve center of the Freedom Movement
